Home Bonus Water

- ~water heater seismic strap kit (lag and tension bolts, washers, spacers, and heavy gauge metal straps)
- ~six-in-one screwdriver
- ~adjustable metal wrench
- ~garden hose, 2-8 feet long
- ~gloves, ~eye protection, ~funnel, or ~Brita filter, empty container
- ~coffee filters and ^eye dropper
- ~small bottle of unscented chlorine bleach. Replace every 6 months—it becomes inactive.
- ~plastic or rubber tubing, 4 feet long

Sanitation

- ~plastic garbage bags to line the buckets (eg Hefty ultra-strong)
- ~2 – 5-gallon general purpose buckets
- ~2 general purpose Leaktite [twister lids](#) for the buckets
- ~ammonia, to clean the buckets after final use
- *plastic [camping toilet seat](#), or a swimming noodle cut lengthwise halfway thru and cut to fit rim
- ~[pine pellet animal bedding](#)—request 3 cu ft by special order
- ~disposable gloves
- ~toilet paper
- ~hand sanitizer

Shelter

- ~gas shut-off tool
- ~fire extinguisher, and go [here to practice how to use one](#)
- ~furniture and picture wall anchors
- *pocket-size reflective emergency blankets
- ~hard hats
- ~leather gloves
- ~flashlights and ~LED lantern
- ~headlamps
- *bicycle tire hand pump, tube patch kit, basic metric wrenches
- @ [free offline bike map](#) (also available at Seattle Public Libraries)
- ~batteries
- ~first aid kit
- ~N95 masks
- *battery-operated radio, *USB portable battery pack
- ~tarp, ~rope, ~zip ties
- ~duct tape
- ~USB storage disk
- ~easy-to-carry rodent-proof containers that fit in your chosen storage space
